
Imagine that you are doing a project on **what sports are popular among teenagers in Zetland**. You have found some data on the subject – the results of the opinion polls (see the table below).

Imagine that you are doing a project on **why teenagers play computer games in Zetland**. You have found some data on the subject – the results of the opinion polls (see the table below).


Comment on the data in the table and give your opinion on the subject of the project.




