Инструкция по выполнению заданий

Устная часть работы по английскому языку включает в себя 4 задания.

Задание 1 – чтение вслух небольшого текста научно-популярного характера. Время на подготовку – 1,5 минуты.

В задании 2 предлагается ознакомиться с рекламным объявлением и задать четыре вопроса на основе ключевых слов. Время на подготовку – 1,5 минуты.

В задании 3 предлагается дать интервью на актуальную тему, развёрнуто ответив на пять вопросов.

В задании 4 предлагается проблемная тема для проектной работы и 2 фотографии, выбор которых в качестве иллюстраций надо обосновать, и нужно выразить своё мнение по проблеме проектной работы. Время на подготовку – 2,5 минуты.

Общее время ответа одного экзаменуемого (включая время на подготовку) – 17 минут.

Каждое последующее задание выдаётся после окончания выполнения предыдущего задания. Всё время ответа ведётся аудио- и видеозапись.

Постарайтесь полностью выполнить поставленные задачи, старайтесь говорить ясно и чётко, не отходить от темы и следовать предложенному плану ответа. Так Вы сможете набрать наибольшее количество баллов.

1 **Task 1. Imagine that you are preparing a project with your friend. You have found some interesting material for the presentation and you want to read this text to your friend. You have 1.5 minutes to read the text silently, then be ready to read it out aloud. You will not have more than 1.5 minutes to read it.**

It is believed that Native American people living in northeastern North America were the first to discover maple syrup. They would make V-shaped cuts in the tree trunks using stone tools, and then insert hollow reeds or pieces of bark into the cuts to collect the sap in buckets. To concentrate the maple sap, they would either drop hot cooking stones into the buckets or leave them outside overnight in freezing temperatures to remove the layer of ice that formed on top. Since sugar does not freeze, removing the ice would increase the concentration of sugar in the remaining liquid. Early European settlers learned about the use of maple syrup from the Native Americans and began making it for themselves as well. By the late 1700s and early 1800s, maple sap was being used to produce a concentrated sugar, both in liquid and crystallized-solid form.

2 **Task 2. Study the advertisement.**

Our Pancake Café is the best in town!



You are considering having breakfast at the Pancake Café and now you'd like to get more information. In 1.5 minutes you are to ask four direct questions to find out about the following:

- 1) how early the café opens in the morning
- 2) types of pancakes they serve
- 3) average price of one serving of pancakes
- 4) whether they offer a takeout option

You have 20 seconds to ask each question.

3 **Task 3. You are going to give an interview. You have to answer five questions. Give full answers to the questions (2–3 sentences). Remember that you have 40 seconds to answer each question.**

4 **Task 4. Imagine that you and your friend are doing a school project “Classical Music for Everyone”. You have found some photos to illustrate it but for technical reasons you cannot send them now. Leave a voice message to your friend explaining your choice of the photos and sharing some ideas about the project. In 2.5 minutes be ready to:**

- explain the choice of the illustrations for the project by briefly describing them and noting the differences;
- mention the advantages (1-2) of listening to these two types of classical music performances;
- mention the disadvantages (1–2) of listening to these two types of classical music performances;
- express your opinion on the subject of the project – which type of classical music performance you'd prefer to listen to and why.

You will speak for not more than 3 minutes (12–15 sentences). You have to talk continuously.
